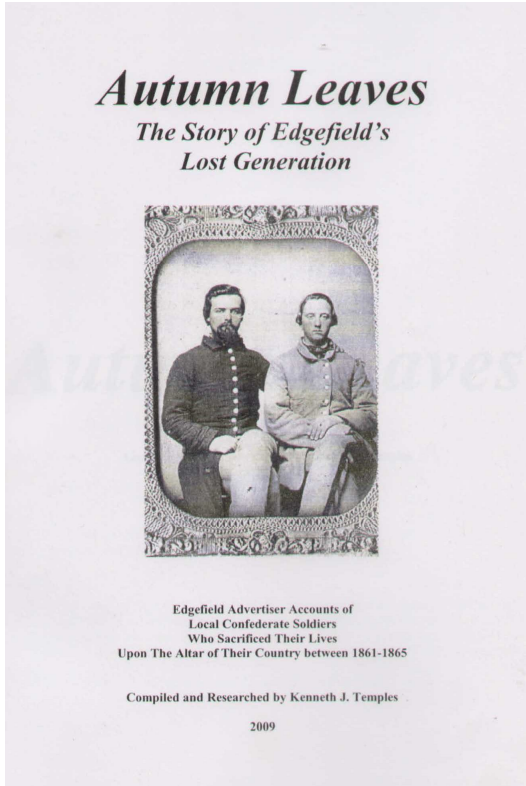


## Press Release

### *AUTUMN LEAVES: THE STORY OF EDGEFIELD'S LOST GENERATION*



Old Edgefield District Genealogical Society (OEDGS) is hosting a book signing on November 15, 2009 at 3:00 p. m. in the Lynch Building Annex, Tompkins Library, 104 Courthouse Square, Edgefield, SC for a wonderful new book titled *Autumn Leaves: The Story of Edgefield's Lost Generation*. This book is an annotated compilation of over 475 Old Edgefield District soldiers who died in service to the Confederacy. *The Edgefield Advertiser* newspaper from 1861-1865 was researched thoroughly and every death notice and tribute was extracted. There are also 13 photos of soldiers associated with Edgefield and 18 photos of soldiers' headstones from

across the South. This 280 page work is indexed and referenced. This is a tremendous asset to Old Edgefield District researchers and enthusiasts.

*Autumn Leaves* was researched and compiled by OEDGS member **Kenneth J. Temples**, also a member of the Sons of Confederate Veterans. He was born and raised in Aiken, SC and has worked for Kroger foods in North Augusta for 35 years. He and his wife, **Marsha Timmerman Temples**, have been married for 34 years and are the parents of three children.
